Proposal/Abstract submission guidelines

1. Title, summary (limited to maximum 400 words), covering, where applicable: purpose, approach, research, implications, and practical implications or applications, keywords, and paper type (research, application, case study, theoretical reaction or theme-session). Workshop formula: presentation, panel discussion, plenary discussion, video or a combination of these forms.
2. Proposal/Abstract submissions should be single-spaced and use 11-point Times New Roman Font with 1 in. (2.54 cm) margins. If you need to include citations, please list them within the same page using APA style. Do not use endnotes or footnotes.
3. Add your résumé/CV with your title(s), registrations, age, education, work setting, research experience, (contextual) publications. Also, include contact information for all authors (name, position, organization, mailing address, email address and phone number).
